Symphyotrichum pilosum

- Daisy-like flowers have yellow centers, that may become reddish with age, are surrounded by white ray florets that may be tinged with blue or violet.
- A must have plant for attracting butterflies and native bees to your garden!
- Also called Hairy White Oldfield Aster, and Awl Aster
- Native to Ontario, Quebec & British Columbia
