Corylus americana

- ❁ Extremely hardy native shrub that can tolerate some shade. Needs a pollinator, (you need at least 2 trees to get nuts)
- ❁ The nuts are sweet and may be eaten raw or ground into flour for cake like bread, they have a very high nutritional value and are eaten by squirrels, foxes, deer, northern bobwhites, ruffed grouse, turkeys and pheasants!
- ❁ Orange-red-purple fall colour
- ❁ Native to Ontario
