

Indian Grass

Sorghastrum Nutans

- ☼ Upright clumps of slender blue-green leaves turn golden yellow to orange in fall. Stiff stems are topped with long, narrow flower heads
- ☼ Provides a good vertical accent in borders and is also effective en masse. This clumping grass provides excellent food and shelter for birds, ducks and upland game birds
- ☼ Leave foliage in place over winter for interest. Cut back to the ground before new growth appears in spring
- ☼ Native from Ontario east to New Brunswick and west to Saskatchewan
