

# Virginia Blue Bells

*Mertensia Virginica*

- ❁ Sapphire blue flowers on tall stems that gleam from shady spots in April and May, making them an ideal underplanting for shrubs and trees.
- ❁ Upright mounds of grey-green leaves, bearing clusters of dangling pink buds that open into bright sapphire-blue bells.
- ❁ Dormant in midsummer, so use other plants to hide any gaps left behind
- ❁ Native to most of Eastern North America
