

Interrupted Fern

Osmunda claytoniana

- ☼ Showy, lance shaped, divided, pale green sterile fronds surround erect central fertile fronds. The fertile fronds are interrupted in the middle by brown leaflets.
- ☼ Also known as Clayton's Fern.
- ☼ Native to Ontario
- ☼ Cut old fronds off before new fronds emerge in spring

Height: 2-3 Feet

Zone: 3
