

Sensitive Fern

Onoclea Sensibilis

- ❁ Long soft green fronds up to 3 foot in length with deeply grooved wavy-toothed leaves
- ❁ Native to Ontario fern
- ❁ Spreads rapidly and suitable for locations where suckering spread is not a problem
- ❁ Sensitive fern gets its name from the tendency of the fronds to wither at the first slight frost
- ❁ Will grow in full sun with adequate moisture
- ❁ Poisonous if ingested

Height: 2-3 Feet
