

Yellow Wild Indigo/Baptisia

Baptisia sphaerocarpa

- ✿ Excellent choice for sunny gardens. Plants form a tall, bushy clump of grey-green foliage, with long spikes of pea-like flowers, in shades of yellow.
- ✿ A good substitute for Lupines, in areas where they are difficult to grow.
- ✿ Makes an excellent cut flower, also attractive to butterflies. Unattractive to slugs, deer and rabbits. Drought tolerant, once established.
- ✿ Native to North America
