

# Blue Ash Tree

*Fraxinus quadrangulata*

- Unique for its 4-sided twigs and loose, scaly maturing bark. Leaves are opposite and compound, toothed leaflets and long tapering tips.
- Unique for its ability to grow in floodplains or dry, sandy limestone outcrops.
- Rare species of ash trees in Ontario. Listed as Threatened and is protected under the Endangered Species Act, 2007.
- Native to Ontario.
