

Clematis

'Kiri te Kanawa'

Clematis x 'Kiri te Kanawa'

6-9" deep blue double blooms with cream stamens & slightly smaller & paler as the season goes on. Blooming time starts in late spring to early summer with some flowers throughout the rest of the summer & well into fall.

A light pruning in late winter\early spring will help produce a well balanced plant. Any weak or dead wood should be removed at this time

Clematis are among the most showy of all the vines. The roots like to be kept cool so cover them with mulch or a ground cover
