

Honey Baby Honeysuckle Vine

Lonicera periclymenum 'Honey Baby

- ❁ Scented blooms open creamy yellow turning to orange yellow from early July to well into the fall. Can be shaped as a bush rather than a climber.
- ❁ Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies to your garden. Extremely easy to grow
- ❁ This vine climbs by twining its stems around narrow supports, like small branches, wires, narrow poles or wood stakes. It won't twine around the trunk of a tree as its diameter is too large and it cannot attach itself to a flat surface without wires for it to curl around
