Aster novae-angliae 'Grape Crush'

- ❁ Very rich, dark purple flowers are produced above dark green foliage in early fall to midfall. Forms a very rounded mound with densely packed flowers.
- ❁ Attractive to butterflies but deer dislike asters immensely
- ❁ Can be used for naturalizing
