

# Midwinter Fire Dogwood

*Cornus Sanguinea 'Midwinter Fire'*

- ☼ Stems are yellowish green during the summer, then turn brilliant orange for winter, yellow at base, shading to fiery red at tips Show stopping when planted en mass
- ☼ White berries are quite attractive to birds adding more ornamental interest
- ☼ Used extensively for its cut branches in winter
- ☼ Good fall burgundy leaf colour
