

Manor Chum

Prunus besseyi x salicina 'Manor'

- ❁ Small dark purple fruits, almost black when ripe, and sweet, dark purple-red flesh. It is often ranked among the best cherry plums.
- ❁ Hardy, naturally dwarf hybrids cross between sandcherries and Japanese plums. Needs another chum (cherry plum) variety nearby for pollination and fruiting.
- ❁ Great for fresh eating, baking, preserving, canning.
