Rosa 'John Davis'

- ❁ The flowers on this rose resemble that of an Old Garden Rose. The 3 1/2" blossoms are very double, somewhat quartered and a light pink color. Blossoms are produced in clusters of up to 17 blossoms and repeat until frost.
- ❁ Very winter hardy with no winter cane dieback. It also has very few thorns and healthy foliage. Grows 6 to 8-feet tall and makes a great pillar or climbing rose. It can also be allowed to ramble
- ❁ Strong musky fragrance
