

Clematis 'Duchess of Edinburgh'

- ❁ One of the best double whites, it features 4-6 inch gorgeous white rosettes that are sometimes tinted pale green
- ❁ Flowers in May - June on old wood and it blooms again in September on the current seasons growth. The second set of blooms are either semi-double or single
- ❁ A light pruning in late winter\early spring will help produce a well balanced plant. Any weak or dead wood should be removed at this time
