

# Sapa Chum

*Prunus besseyi x salicina* 'Sapa'

- Small purplish fruit with mauve coloured flesh, noted for their sweet tart flavour and early production .
- Hardy, naturally dwarf hybrids cross between sandcherries and Japanese plums. Needs another chum (cherry plum) variety nearby for pollination and fruiting.
- Great for fresh eating, baking, preserving, canning.
