Monarda fistulosa

- ❁ Masses of fragrant lilac-purple tubular flowers borne in dense globular heads from mid summer to early fall
- ❁ Flowers are edible and can be used to garnish plates, add to a cool summer salad or to make tea with the leaves
- ❁ A must have plant for attracting hummingbirds and butterflies to your garden!
- ❁ Native to Ontario & Quebec
