

Porcupine Grass

Miscanthus sinensis 'Strictus'

- ❁ Porcupine grass and zebra grass look quite similar. Both are variegated green and cream, bearing horizontal strips along their stems. Porcupine grass, however, is noted for its very upright growth habit, reminiscent of porcupine quills. Zebra grass tends to arch over and sometimes 'flops'
- ❁ Plumes are a rich reddish bronze
- ❁ Warm season grass-likes to grow in warm weather, before it will show signs of life in the spring the soil must warm up and be warm possibly for as long as 2 weeks
