

# Clematis 'Barbara Dibley'

*Clematis x 'Barbara Dibley'*



Soft reddish-mauve 6-8 inch blossoms in May, June & September. Holds its colour best in part shade.

A light pruning in late winter\early spring will help produce a well balanced plant. Any weak or dead wood should be removed at this time

Clematis are among the most showy of all the vines. The roots like to be kept cool so cover them with mulch or a ground cover
