

Golden Groundsel

Packera aurea

Clusters of small golden daisy-like flowers appear over broad, shiny green, toothed basal leaves in May. A strong bloomer, even in the shade, and is a robust groundcover. Golden-yellow blooms make way for fluffy seedheads that self-sow and naturalize. Easy to grow, golden ragwort grows from 6-12" tall and tolerates dry shade conditions. In shaded gardens, where seasonal color can be hard to come by, provides a long season of cheery blooms in early spring as it spreads by seed and roots into dense colonies. Deer resistant, will smother
