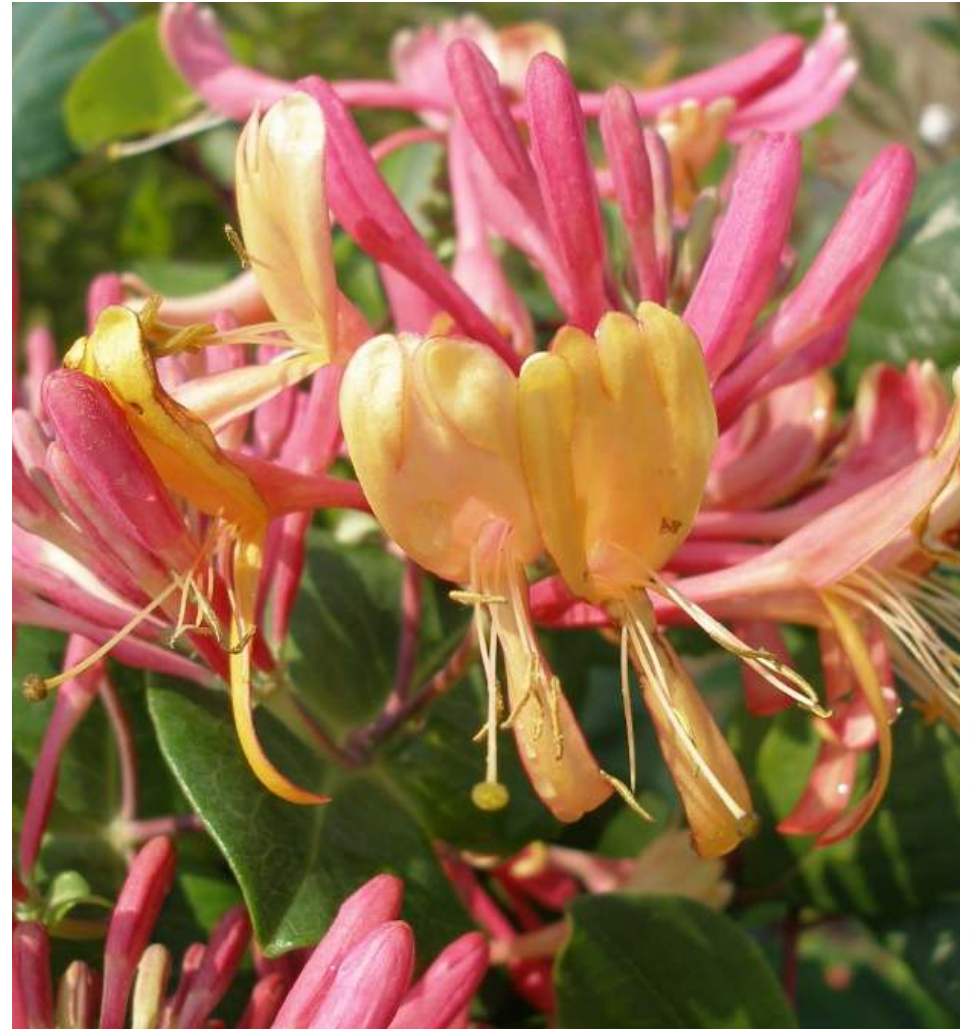


Goldflame Honeysuckle

Lonicera x Heckrottii 'Goldflame'

- ❁ Long tubular bicolor flowers of pink and golden yellow, sweet/spicy fragrance, an older cultivar but still one of the best Honeysuckle out there. Flowers are produced in large heads continually all summer long on this non aggressive, easy to grow vine. Also attracts hummingbirds and butterflies to your garden
- ❁ This vine climbs by twining its stems around narrow supports, like small branches, wires, narrow poles or wood stakes. It won't twine, say, around the trunk of a shade tree as its diameter is too large and it cannot attach itself to a flat surface without wires for it to curl around
