

# Northern Bayberry

*Myrica pensylvanica*

- ❁ Dark green aromatic foliage persists late into fall on this native plant
- ❁ Clusters of gray, waxy, aromatic berries that also persist well into winter and are used to make bayberry candles
- ❁ Tolerates a wide range of conditions from wet to dry, soil compaction, wind and salt, sun or shade
- ❁ Suckers freely and is great for screening
- ❁ Native to Ontario
