

# Red Currant

*Ribes rubrum*

- ❁ Clusters of greenish-yellow flowers bloom in spring. Flowers give way to long, pendant clusters of large deep red currants which ripen in July.
- ❁ Leaves are aromatic when crushed.
- ❁ Self pollinating. Low maintenance plant that does well in most soils but is most comfortable in moist well drained locations
- ❁ Red currants, although tart, may be eaten ripe off the shrub, but are perhaps more often harvested to make jams, jellies and pies.
