

Wild Ramps

Allium tricoccum

- ❁ Long, glossy, oval leaves appear in early spring and wither away before the flowering stalk matures. Small white flowers. Plant has a mild onion taste.
- ❁ The foliage and bulbs can be used in salads and soups. Native Americans treated stings with juice from the crushed bulbs.
- ❁ North American species of wild onion or garlic widespread across eastern Canada (Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island) and the eastern United States.
