

New England Aster

Symphyotrichum novae-angliae

- Abundant blooms consist of large rose-purple petals around a central golden cone in late summer into fall. Leaves have a spicy aroma when crushed.
- A must have plant for attracting butterflies to your garden!
- Great for planting near water and rain gardens, in the woodland setting or for cut flowers.
- Also called Michaelmas daisy
- Native to Ontario & Quebec

Height: 2-5 Feet
