

Hairy Wood Mint

Blephilia hirsuta

- ❁ Central stems are covered with long white hairs and end in several whorls of flowers
- ❁ Long bloom duration and can form dense colonies in open woods and along the forest edge. A nice source of nectar and pollen make Hairy Wood Mint a great native plant beneficial to bees and other pollinators.
- ❁ The leaves will give off a mint smell/aroma when crushed
- ❁ Native to Ontario & Quebec
