

# Wild Blueberry

*Vaccinium angustifolium*

Wild Blueberries are a native fruit crop to Atlantic Canada, Quebec and Ontario. They are short in stature and unlike their Highbush cousins spread with underground stems. A mature planting can form a dense ground cover. The leaves are glossy blue-green in summer, turning purple in the fall. The sweet, small dark blue berries are used in preserves and pies and are high in antioxidants

Needs acidic soil (adding compost will acidify your soil)
