- ☼ Showy round clusters of red to purplish flowers, arranged in large, shaggy heads are held above dark green aromatic foliage.
- ☼ Flowers are edible and can be used to garnish plates, add to a cool summer salad or to make tea with the leaves. A must have plant for attracting hummingbirds and butterflies to your garden!
- ☼ Also known as Scarlet Bee Balm, Bergamot, Horsemint, or Oswego Tea
- ☼ Native to Ontario & Quebec
