

Blue False Indigo/Baptisia

Baptisia australis

- ❁ False Indigo is an excellent choice for sunny gardens. Plants form a tall, bushy clump of grey-green foliage, with long spikes of pea-like flowers, in shades of violet-blue.
- ❁ A good substitute for Lupines, in areas where they are difficult to grow.
- ❁ Makes an excellent cut flower, also attractive to butterflies. Unattractive to slugs, deer and rabbits. Drought tolerant, once established.
- ❁ Native to Ontario
