Euphorbia Polychroma/Epithymoides

- ☼ Bright yellow bracts top a compact mound of foliage in early spring. Foliage turns brilliant red in the fall. Extremely drought tolerant and should be planted in a dry spot
- ☼ Be aware of is the milky sap that exudes from broken stems or leaves-it's not good to get in your eyes or on skin-its very irritating. Toxic if eaten
