

# Big Bluestem

*Andropogon gerardii*

- ❁ Flat leaves emerge gray to blue green in spring, mature to green with red tinges in summer & turn reddish bronze with lavender tones in autumn after frost. In late summer flowering stems arise bearing purplish 3-parted, finger-like flower clusters .
- ❁ Drought tolerant and prefers poorer soils
- ❁ Also known as Turkey Foot Grass
- ❁ Native to Ontario, Manitoba, Quebec & Saskatchewan
