## Black Currant Consort

Ribes 'Consort'

- Clusters of yellow-green flowers give way to medium size, sweet-tart grape like flavoured, black fruit with hints of cherry. Self pollinating and heavy producing
- Black currants, although tart, may be eaten ripe off the shrub, but are perhaps more often harvested to make jams, jellies, pies and freeze well.
- Makes a great hedge or border plant.


