Halesia carolina

- ❁ Pretty white bell-shaped flowers hang in clusters in April and early May. The leaves turn shades of yellow in fall.
- ❁ Naturally forms multiple stems but can be trained into a tree form by removing all but one central trunk.
- ❁ Great for woodland borders or a specimen plant. Attracts native bees.
- ❁ Choose a location where you will be able to stand under the tree or otherwise look upward to it, as this is the best way to see the flowers.
